# \*to the word "BEAR" that holds many meanings:

to carry the weight of, support, endure (an ordeal or difficulty), an animal, rugged masculinity, important & worth repeating, a spiritual guide representing strength & self-knowledge, elemental forces, primal power, sovereignty, intuition; instinct, giving birth, to pay a price or suffer a consequence, a toy (Teddy bear)—innocent and lovable, (slang) something difficult or unpleasant, dangerous uncontrolled unconscious.

### \*OR to the word "BARE" that holds several meanings:

naked, stripped down, empty; to show (bare teeth)

### \*OR to an aspect of the Bear Fever public art project

Responding to the Bear Fever sculptures is another option. Perhaps the sponsor's mission or details that the artist displayed on a sculpture will inspire a reflection or response. (visit www.bearfever.org for information and images of the sculptures)

#### \*OR to an aspect about The Fairy Tale "Goldilocks & the Three Bears"

Perhaps some aspect of the tale--"everything in moderation," "respecting others' space," or how actions may hurt others--may inspire a reflection or response.

There is no submission charge. Include a 2-3 sentence bio along with your submission. Bios may be edited. Submissions will be published in the digital news site The Boyertown Area Expression\_(boyertownareaexpression.town.news) throughout the summer of 2025.
